










## Low Bandwidth Teaching Matrix



Download and install the Zotero file as you would download other software applications.


#### **Using Zotero with Chromebooks**

Step 1. Go to zotero.org and click on Log In.




Step 2. Click on Web Library.




Step 3. You can build your library in the browser version following the same procedure outlined for the app.




