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#### **DEFINING COIL**

Collaborative Online International Learning

•Faculty residing in different countries develop a shared curricular project and integrate it in their existing courses (same or different disciplines). Students engage in collaborative activities using online tools (synchronous and asynchronous).

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#### Terminology

- COIL is a SUNY term (emphasizes collaboration)
- •Other terms to describe the practice: Virtual Exchange, Telecollaboration, Online Intercultural Exchange

#### STEP 2: GET TO KNOW YOUR COIL PARTNER

#### FIND OUT AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE

- PROFESSIONAL AND PERSONAL BACKGROUND
- RESEARCH INTERESTS
- COURSES TAUGHT
- TEACHING PHILOSOPHY (IMPORTANT!)
- COURSE FOR COIL
- UNIVERSITY CULTURE
- STUDENTS
- ACADEMIC CALENDAR

## STEP 3: DESIGN A COIL MODULE WITH FACULTY PARTNER

#### Duration

- 4 weeks (at least recommended)
- Structure
  - Informational exchange (ice-breaker, community building)
  - Comparison/analysis (compare a topic across cultures)
  - Collaborative project (student-generated content, working together toward a common goal and overcoming differences)





  - DEVELOP A COIL REFLECTION PROMPT FOR QUALITATIVE ASSESSMENT


