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# DEFINING COIL

## Collaborative Online International Learning

- Faculty residing in different countries develop a shared curricular project and integrate it in their existing courses (same or different disciplines). Students engage in collaborative activities using online tools (synchronous and asynchronous).

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## Terminology

- COIL is a SUNY term (emphasizes collaboration)
- Other terms to describe the practice: **Virtual Exchange, Telecollaboration, Online Intercultural Exchange**

# When to COIL?

- COIL WHEN your students can benefit from:
  - Comparing issues, policies, and beliefs across cultures
  - Exploring global ethics (for instance, ethical tourism, COVID-19)
  - Perspective shifting such as problematizing US-centric views on a topic
  - Providing or receiving international peer mentorship
  - Addressing and receiving feedback from international peer audience

## **STEP 2: GET TO KNOW YOUR COIL PARTNER**

  - **COURSES TAUGHT**
  - **TEACHING PHILOSOPHY (IMPORTANT!)**
  - **COURSE FOR COIL**
  - **UNIVERSITY CULTURE**

  - **ACADEMIC CALENDAR**

**STEP 3:  
DESIGN A COIL  
MODULE WITH  
FACULTY  
PARTNER**

- Duration
  - 4 weeks (at least recommended)
  - Structure
    - Informational exchange (ice-breaker, community building)
    - Comparison/analysis (compare a topic across cultures)
    - Collaborative project (student-generated content, working together toward a common goal and overcoming differences)
